6.6 **Regional Collaborative Service Delivery**

- Regional Collaborative Service Delivery (RCSD) is a regional partnership among school authorities, Alberta Health Services (AHS), Human Services and other community stakeholders.
- RCSD is about using the resources already in place more effectively by working together. This can include, but is not limited to existing mental health supports, speech-language therapy and occupational therapy.
- RCSD partners collaborate on a regional level to help meet the identified needs of children, youth and their families. The intention of the RCSD approach is that children, youth and families will have access to existing and enhanced supports at the right time and in their home, school and community.



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- Regional Collaborative Service Delivery is intended to better meet the needs of:
Children or youth registered in Early Childhood Services (ECS) to Grade 12
Children and youth with complex needs* between the ages of 0 and 20 years old
Children and youth (from birth to age 20) with a low incidence disability including:
 - Blind or Visually Impaired (BVI);
 - Deaf or Hard of Hearing (DHH);
 - Deafblind (DB); and
 - Complex Communication Needs (CNN).
- School staff, families and service providers who need cross-sector training or skill development in relation to collaboratively supporting children and youth in school and the community
- *Children and youth with complex needs are those who require significant extraordinary care and require services from more than one government ministry.
- This may include children and youth with: multiple impairments, complex mental health and health issues and/or severe behavioral needs, for whom all currently available resources have been utilized with limited success, who require fiscal and human resources that strain the capacity of any one ministry, or for whom there are questions about the safety of the child, youth, family, or public.
